SHOW RULES

The show is for amateurs only. Every exhibit shall be the property and production of the Exhibitor.

Entry fee 50p per exhibit, except in the Children's section, where entries are free.

Exhibitors must provide their own vases, plates, etc. for all exhibits. Exhibitors exhibiting fruit, vegetable and cookery items must be on a paper plate.

A maximum of 2 entries in each class per person. Entry forms with fee, to be handed to :Amanda Stoneman, 76, Churchfields Road, Folkingham, NOT LATER THAN 23rd AUGUST, 2025
Exhibits - Should only be brought to the Village Hall on Saturday morning between 09.00 a.m. and 10.30 a.m. and not before. No exhibits to be removed before 4.30 p.m., but must be collected by 5.00 p.m. Exhibitors who are unable to collect their exhibits between 4.30 - 5.00 p.m. MUST make alternative arrangements.

Although every care will be taken, the Committee accepts no responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage to exhibits.

Judges are to be appointed by the Committee. Judges shall have the power to withhold any prize if it is considered that the exhibit has insufficient merit, or in the event of a dispute, divide the prize.

The Committee's decision shall be final in the case of a dispute or judgement. The Committee will not be responsible for the loss of, or the damage to any exhibit.

Challenge cups are to be competed for in the current year and cannot be won outright. In the case of a tie the trophy shall be held for six months each. Cups are to be returned to the Secretary by 31st July the following year.
